RUBJERG KNUDE FYR

At the edge of the North Sea, you can find the famous Rubjerg Knude Fyr (Rubjerg Knude Lighthouse), which was built in 1900 and whose light served as a landmark for ships in Danish waters until 1968. However, sand drift caused the sand dune to grow and eventually, a large part of the lighthouse was buried. The sand drift has continued over time, and therefore the lighthouse was moved 70 meters in 2019.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE TRIP

This tour will offer a guided tour of Lønstrup, where you can experience its cozy atmosphere up close. With a visit to a glassblowing workshop, the tour also provides insight into Lønstrup's rich culture of craftsmanship. Additionally, at the end, there will be an opportunity to explore the town on your own, and the guide will provide inspiration for the best dining spots.

After the visit to Lønstrup, the tour will continue to Rubjerg Knude Lighthouse. The tractor bus, Knuden, will transport you to Rubjerg Knude Lighthouse, where you can then explore the lighthouse and its surroundings or go all the way to the top of the lighthouse to enjoy the view of the surrounding landscape.
